To strengthen and amplify the success of women in the construction industry.

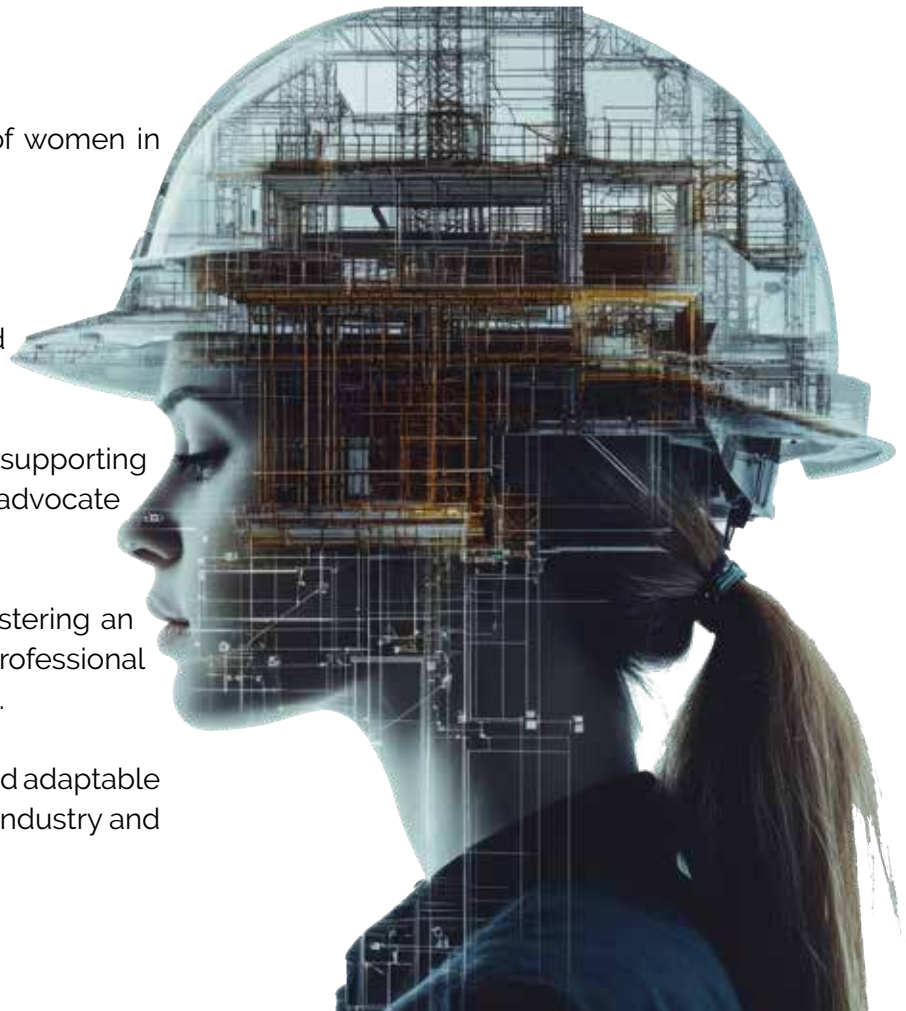
Core Values

REQUIREMENTS AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be enrolled (or enrolling) as a full-time student. Part-time students are not eligible for awards. Applicant must desire a career in a construction-related field.

- b. Resume, if available
- c. Evaluation/Letter of Recommendation completed by one of your instructors
- d. Application Questionnaire

AWARDS

1. Application will be reviewed and winners selected by the NAWIC Greater Little Rock Chapter #12 Scholarship Committee, which will consider each applicant's extracurricular activities, employment experience, evaluations, work ethic, passion for construction, and resilience.
2. All applicants selected as semi-finalists may be subject to a personal interview with the Directors of the NAWIC Greater Little Rock Chapter #12 Scholarship Committee.
3. Scholarships are not automatically renewed, but the student can reapply for subsequent awards.
